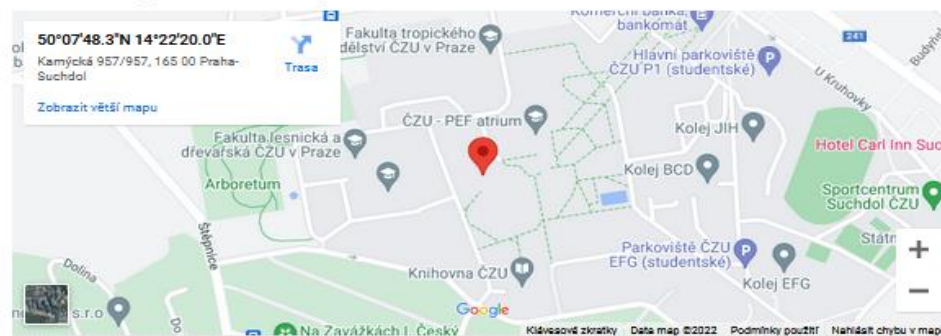

Study information

- Academic year is divided into two semesters:
 - an autumn/winter (AS/WS) and
 - a summer/spring (SS) semester.
- Each subject consists of a lecture and a practical training (seminar) – attendance is compulsory:
 - 2 teaching hours of lectures a week = 90 minutes
 - 1-2 teaching hours of practical training a week
 - 1 teaching hour lasts 45 minutes



Study information

- Each subject has a code in which the last letter indicates the mode of completion of subject
 - **Z**EX01**Z** (Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration) → Z (započet) = creditation (e.g. test)
 - **A**AA41**E** (Advanced Meteorology and Climatology) → E = creditation (e.g. test) + **exam** (i.e. no credits without passing the exam)
- In this case, creditation is an assumption for being able to take an exam.
- Exams can be oral or written.
- Grading system for exams: 1 – excellent; 2 – very good; 3 – good; 4 – fail

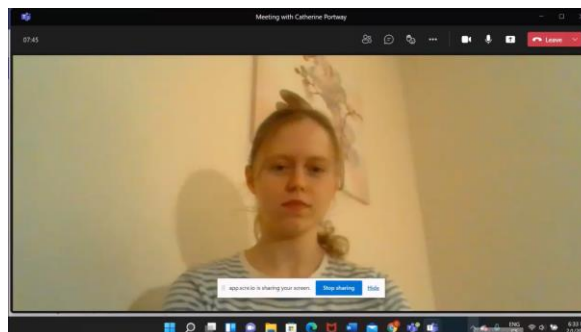


Introduction to MS Teams, Moodle

How to access MS Teams in case of online teaching:

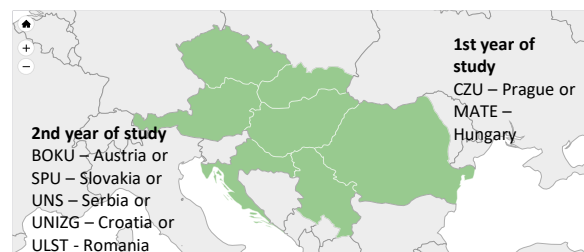

Erasmus Mundus Danube AgriFood Joint Master programme

- Exclusive scholarship programme financed by the EU
- Study focus: **sustainability in agriculture, food production and technology** in the Danube region (model region for all riparian regions worldwide)
- Study at 2 out of 7 partner universities



- Tuition fee:
 - **Scholarship** (approximately **EUR 1 400/month**) – applicant does not pay tuition fee; or
 - **Tuition fee waiver** - applicant does not pay tuition fee, applicant covers all other expenses related to study in a given country (e.g. living and travel costs); or
 - **Selfpayer option** – applicant pays tuition fee of CZK 80 000 for first year of study at CZU, tuition fees of other universities are available upon request.
- **Applications deadline** – EU citizens: **31st March 2023**
