## Faculty of Agrobiology, Food and Natural Resources (hereinafter "FAFNR") of the CZECH UNIVERSITY OF LIFE SCIENCES IN PRAGUE (hereinafter "CULS")

Supplement to Scholarship Rules of the CULS regarding the conditions for acknowledgment of a Merit Scholarship for students of Bachelor's and Master's Study Programmes, valid in the academic year 2019/2020

The merit scholarship can be granted by the Dean of the FAFNR to students of the FAFNR for excellent study results in the previous academic year based on their request according to criteria set each year by the management of the FAFNR.

The following criteria for obtaining the merit scholarship for the academic year 2018/2019 were agreed by the management of the faculty:

- Obtain the maximum number of ECTS, set by the study plan of the respective programme and year of study;
- The full amount of the merit scholarship if the study average is up to 1,10 inclusive, i.e.
  12 000 Kč;
- Two thirds of the amount of the merit scholarship if the study average is in the range from 1,11 1,20 inclusive, i.e. **8 000 Kč**;
- A third of the amount of the merit scholarship if the study average is in the range from 1,21 1,30 inclusive, i.e. 4 000 Kč;
- The merit scholarship is not awarded when the study plan is not fulfilled (e.g. repeating of a year of study, transferring the subjects to the following year of study) or in case of an individual study plan;
- Exams undertaken as part of other study programmes are not counted into the study plan;
- The scholarship is paid out for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year of Bachelor's studies, and also for the 1<sup>st</sup> year of Master's studies.

The request for the merit scholarship is to submitted by the student to the International Relations Office of the FAPPZ by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019 at the latest.
