

Supplement to CZU Scholarship Rules regarding the conditions for awarding a merit scholarship for students of bachelor's and master's degree programmes taught in English at the Faculty of Agrobiography, Food and Natural Resources, valid in the academic year 2021/2022

The merit scholarship may be awarded by the dean of the faculty to students of the following bachelor's and master's degree programmes taught in English:

- B-AGRIFOB: Agriculture and Food
- B-SUNRB: Sustainable Use of Natural Resources
- N-AGRIFOM: Sustainable Agriculture and Food Security
- N-ENVIM: Natural Resources and Environment
- N-NARMEE: Natural Resources Management and Ecological Engineering

The scholarship is awarded for excellent study results in the past academic year based on criteria set annually by the faculty management. A request for scholarship needs to be submitted by a student for the scholarship to be awarded.

The following criteria for obtaining the merit scholarship for the academic year 2020/2021 were agreed by the management of the faculty:

- Obtain the maximum number of ECTS, set by the study plan of the respective study programme and year of study,
- Scholarship in the amount of 50% of the annual tuition fee is awarded if the study average is in the range of 1.0 - 1.20 inclusive,
- Scholarship in the amount of 30% of the annual tuition fee is awarded if the study average is in the range of 1.21 - 1.50 inclusive,
- Scholarship in the amount of 20% of the annual tuition fee is awarded if the study average is in the range of 1.51 - 1.80 inclusive,
- Scholarship in the amount of 10% of the annual tuition fee is awarded if the study average is in the range of 1.81 – 2.00 inclusive,
- The merit scholarship is not awarded when the study plan is not fulfilled (e.g. repeating of a year of study, transferring the subjects to the following year of study) or in case of an individual study plan (with the exception of a study stay abroad within the Erasmus+ programme),
- Exams undertaken as part of other study programmes are not counted into the study plan,
- The scholarship is paid out retrospectively for the completed 1st and 2nd year of bachelor's study programme, as well as for the 1st year of master's study programme,
- Students enrolled into the 1st year of master's study programme who completed a bachelor's study of an English taught programme at the faculty, may apply for a merit scholarship for the completed 3rd year of bachelor's study,
- Payment of the full amount of tuition fee set for the past academic year was made.

The request for a merit scholarship is to be submitted by the student to the International Relations Office of the faculty once the student completes his/her study year, by 31st October 2021 at the latest.
